We called on the cerebral palsy community for ideas that could change the world for someone with cerebral palsy.

Alper in Turkey sent the idea for a solar powered wheelchair.



#### Then last year in 2022, Rana Zarzour from Lebanon sent the idea "Mother's connection"

As a mother of a non-verbal child, Rana feels like she is always guessing the reason behind her daughter's cries, anger or pain.


Inspired by the technology that creates artificial pain for men to experience childbirth.

Rana wants to see technology created that can simulate a child's needs and help better guide caregivers.

Rana's idea shaped one of the challenges for the 2023 <u>Remarkable</u> <u>Design-athon</u>.

#### <u>Run a workshop</u>

Invite the community to come together and generate ideas in a workshop. This could be done virtually or in-person. Your workshop should have activities to help people come up with the biggest and brightest ideas they possibly can.

Remember idea submissions are open until 11.59PM on World Cerebral Palsy Day, 6 October.


#### **Activities:**

- Go around the room or Zoom, and have people share their gripes around accessibility. What's a bad experience they've had which didn't have to be that way?
- Write each of these as 'How-might-we statements' and brainstorm the solutions for example "How-might we-make air travel easier for wheelchair users?"
- 8 in 8 activity. participants fold a piece of paper 3 times so that there are 8 squares. Set an 8 minute timer and everyone individually thinks of 8 ideas to fill each of their squares. Share the ideas with the group. This type of quick brainstorming can come up with great ideas and starting points!



Run an event where people from the cerebral palsy community pitch their life-changing ideas to a panel. They can describe the idea, the problem it would solve and how they saw it coming to life.

Invite a panel of influencers to give feedback This can happen in-person, or as a virtual event. Encourage attendees to enter their own ideas on the website.






### Voting day

# Join the live event




